

SCHOOL-PARENT-SCHOLAR COMPACT

The Beta Academy Staff, scholars and parents of the Houston community, agree that this compact outlines parents, school staff, and scholars will share responsibility for improved scholar academic achievement and the means by which the school and parents will build and develop a partnership that will help children achieve the state's high standards.

SCHOOL RESPONSIBILITIES

Beta Academy staff will:

- 1. Provide high-quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment that supports children in meeting the state's scholar academic achievement standards.
- 2. Provide parents with frequent reports on their children's academic and behavioral progress. In each classroom we will provide progress reports through Parent/Teacher conferences, samples of scholar work, and updates on reading, writing and math assessments. We will initiate a parent contact at the first sign of behavior patterns that interfere with scholar learning.
- 3. Set high expectations for staff, scholars and parents by ensuring challenging curriculum, implementing programs targeted at increasing scholar achievement and committing to recruit, retain, and train qualified staff. Also, highlight/prepare ways that the parent can advance the learning environment at home.
- 4. Provide parents opportunities to volunteer and participate in their child's class, and to observe classroom activities, as defined by grade level teams.
- 5. Provide parents reasonable access to staff.

PARENT RESPONSIBILITIES

I, as a Beta Academy parent, will support my children's learning in the following ways:

- 1. Establish routines to support my child's success in school:
 - appropriate bedtime
 - nutrition
 - grooming & hygiene
 - following dress code
